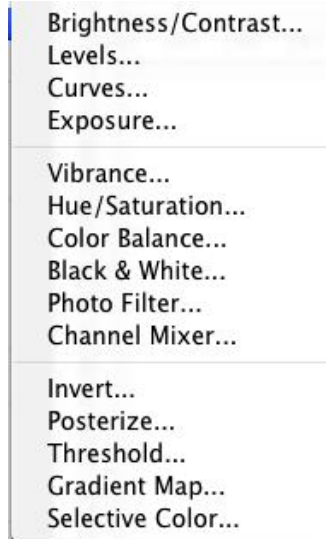


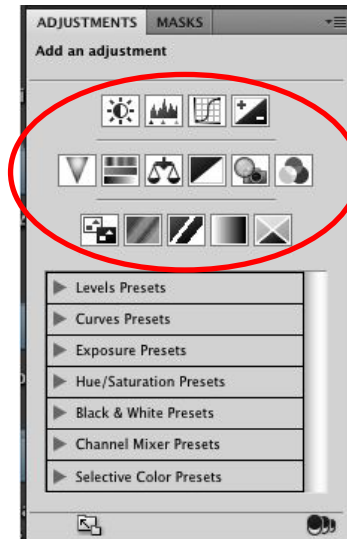

04_Adjustment Layers

Adjustment Layers in Photoshop are used to colorize, brighten, invert your image (negative), etc. Adjustment Layers contain no pixels—and they are non-destructive, since they can be turned on or off. An Adjustment Layer only affects the layer(s) below it, or can be assigned to only one layer at a time. Here are the choices, in the Layer Menu and in the Adjustment Panel:



Adjustment Layers in Layer Menu



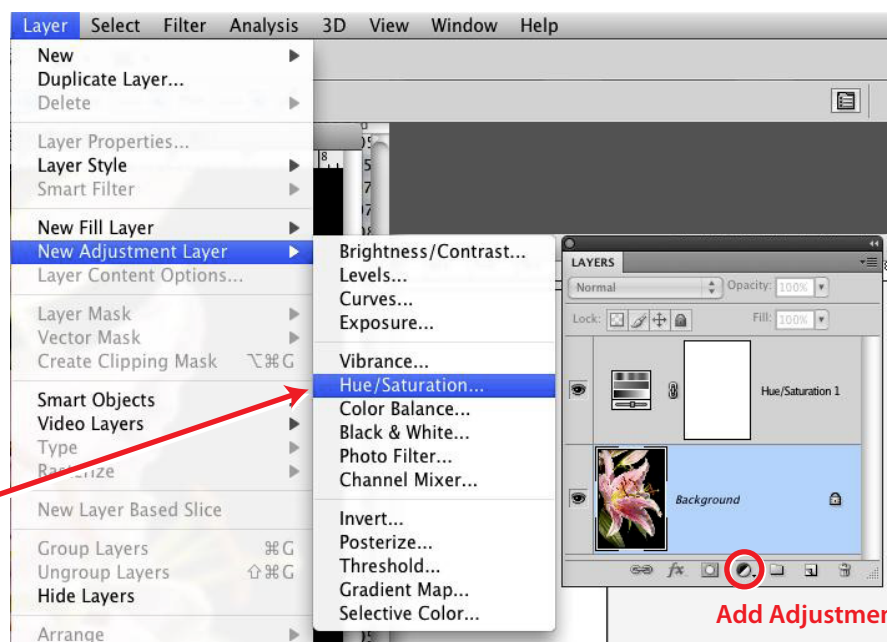
Adjustment Layers Panel

1. Open the *04_Adjustment Layers* folder, and then open the *flower.jpg* image in Photoshop:

2. To Add a **Hue & Saturation** Adjustment Layer, choose:
Layer > New Adjustment Layer > Hue/Saturation ...
